

## Little Chick's Cheat Sheet

**Listed below are some helpful resources to make your nest egg calculations a little easier.**

10k = 0.4166 fine gold

To get the cost of 10k, multiply the cost of fine gold by 0.4166

14k = 0.5833 fine gold

To get the cost of 14k, multiply the cost of fine gold by 0.5833

18k = 0.750 fine gold

To get the cost of 18k, multiply the cost of fine gold by 0.750

22k = 0.9166 fine gold

To get the cost of 22k, multiply the cost of fine gold by 0.9166

24k = 0.9999 fine gold

To get the cost of 24k, multiply the cost of fine gold by 0.9999

### **Helpful Conversions**

1 gram (g) = 0.03215 Troy oz (oz.)

To convert grams to oz, multiply by 0.03215

### **Quality Marks**

Platinum (PL, PT, or PLAT) can be  
850 to 950 parts per thousand of platinum

18k may be marked with 750

G.P., G.E.P., and H.G.E after a karat value  
indicate electroplating

G.F. after a karat value indicates gold filled

Vermeil is gold overlay on sterling silver.
